Fostering generosity: The students participate in initiatives to support the underserved segments of society, such as elderly and orphans. By teaching the youngsters, students provide assistance to the orphans. Students volunteer in the nursing homes for the elderly. During the AshadhiWari festival, which takes place every year in Maharashtra, nearly three million devotees walk together between the cities of Alandi and Pandharpur over a distance of around 250 kilometers. By cleaning the travelers' temporary homes, the Institute's students voluntarily assist those on the road for AshadhiWari. Students also served as Police-Mitra (Friends of Police) during the month of Ashadh to assist the police in controlling traffic in the city when devotees were staying there.

Physical development: The institution encourages students to participate in physical activities to help them develop a variety of crucial abilities, including physical fitness, teamwork, self-assurance, decision-making, mental toughness, etc. The school sponsors yearly sporting activities for the students that include a variety of games including cricket, volleyball, throw ball, kabaddi, chess, carom, etc. Boys and girls both engage in and demonstrate their talents in these activities, and as a result, their sportsmanship and capacity for teamwork develop. Every year, the institution observes International Yoga Day. Numerous physical activities, including yoga, exercises, outdoor sports, and others are undertaken at the camps hosted in different villages that the institute has adopted via NSS.

Emotional development: The institution gives the students' emotional well-being the appropriate amount of attention. Students are guaranteed at least once every two weeks of interaction with teachers thanks to the mentor-mentee system that is in place. Students may talk to the instructors about their academics and personal issues during these sessions. The pupils get appropriate guidance from the mentor-faculty. For a group of 15-20 girl students, there are designated female mentors at the institution who meet with the girl students on a regular basis, identify their challenges, if any, and provide advice on potential solutions.
