Faster, cheaper, and faster are what differentiates us from the throng in terms of individual creative contribution as the globe continues to sprint towards innovation. The more we share and produce, the more we realize how important this notion is. Creativity is not something that can be outsourced; it must be nurtured, challenged, and driven by human curiosity.  He emphasized how the idea that everyone has the ability to be creative does not successfully boost competition and makes it more difficult to be recognized as a professional creative industries practitioner. Even though everyone is creative or innovative in some manner, this does not guarantee success. This is due to three major factors. Some individuals have a better capacity for creativity and imagination than others. Some individuals lack the time and resources required to realize their creative potential. Others just believe that they cannot earn a career from their creativity and hence do not embrace or develop their imagination.  A total of 145 students attended the event, and the speaker answered their questions.
